13 years and earning recognition as Outstanding Troop in the State of
14 Texas in 1973; and

15 WHEREAS, Active participants in Boy Scouts of America events,
16 troop members have traveled to Virginia and Idaho for the National
17 Jamboree and attended the National Order of the Arrow conference at
18 Indiana University; on March 12, 2003, the troop will spend the
19 night aboard the USS *Lexington* in Corpus Christi; and
