1           WHEREAS, The Texas House of Representatives is pleased to  
2 join the citizens of Round Rock in celebrating the Daffodil Days  
3 festival, which has become one of the town's most successful  
4 beautification endeavors and heralds the blooming of this lovely  
5 flower in the community each year; and

6           WHEREAS, Eight years ago, the Round Rock Senior Citizens  
7 Foundation began hosting the Daffodil Days event to encourage the  
8 beautification of the city with these attractive flowers and to  
9 raise funds to renovate a building for use as a senior citizens  
10 center; and

11           WHEREAS, Since that time, the event has continued to support  
12 programs benefiting the town's older citizens and area residents  
13 have been encouraged to plant approximately 30,000 bulbs as a part  
14 of their business and home beautification plans; and

15           WHEREAS, To celebrate the coming of spring and the blooming  
16 of the flowers, the Daffodil Days festival is held each year on the  
17 first Saturday of March; family entertainment is provided, and food  
18 and arts and crafts booths add to the event's popularity; and

21 to gather and celebrate the beauty of this spring flower while  
22 further contributing to the resources available to the area's  
23 senior citizens; now, therefore, be it
