R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, The family and friends of Brent Kyle Bischoff of  
2 Corpus Christi were profoundly saddened by the untimely passing of  
3 this extraordinary young man on December 29, 1997; and

4           WHEREAS, Born into a Navy family on May 19, 1979, at the Naval  
5 Hospital in Portsmouth, Virginia, Mr. Bischoff was baptized at the  
6 Naval Air Station Chapel in Norfolk, Virginia; he was later  
7 confirmed into the Lutheran Church at Dreifaltigkeits Church in  
8 Worms, Germany; and

9           WHEREAS, Mr. Bischoff lived in Virginia Beach, Virginia,  
10 until the age of seven, when his family moved to Stuttgart, Germany;  
11 he attended third, fourth, and fifth grades at the Patch American  
12 Elementary School on the United States Army post, and while there he  
13 acquired a lasting interest in soccer; returning to Virginia in  
14 1988, Mr. Bischoff continued to play soccer as well as street  
15 hockey, and he developed his talent for art; and

16           WHEREAS, In 1990, the Bischoff family moved back to Germany,  
17 and during this stay the young man nurtured a deeper connection to  
18 his ancestral homeland; he formed many lifelong friendships,  
19 discovered the beauty found in the vast German forests and  
20 mountains, and learned alpine skiing in the mountains of Germany,  
21 Austria, and Switzerland; and

22           WHEREAS, Mr. Bischoff accumulated an array of experiences in  
23 Germany, including further evolving his gift for art under the  
24 tutelage of his art teacher at Patch American High School; he

1 traveled to the Czech Republic to play baseball and competed on the  
2 Patch Barracks youth soccer team, which won the U.S. Forces  
3 All-Europe Soccer Championship in 1992; in addition, he enjoyed  
4 skateboarding, in-line skating, and playing the guitar; and

5 WHEREAS, When his family returned to the United States and  
6 moved to Corpus Christi in 1994, Mr. Bischoff attended Mary Carroll  
7 High School, where his personable and outgoing character enabled  
8 him to make numerous lasting friendships; under the guidance of his  
9 art teacher, Lynda Jones, he pursued his interest in art and was  
10 awarded a college scholarship; he also explored his musical talent,  
11 with a special affinity for Ska music, and formed a band called The  
12 Special Guests; and

13 WHEREAS, A good and loyal son, Mr. Bischoff held a special  
14 bond with his younger brother, Kurt, with whom he shared many happy  
15 times, and those memories will be cherished forever; and

16 WHEREAS, Brent is remembered for his smile, his love of life,  
17 and his many talents; a leader and a friend, he was selfless and  
18 dignified, and his spirit will continue to live in the hearts of  
19 those who were fortunate enough to have known him; now, therefore,  
20 be it

21 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 78th Texas  
22 Legislature hereby pay special tribute to the life of Brent Kyle  
23 Bischoff and that sincere sympathy be extended to the members of his  
24 family: to his parents, Chris and Patricia Bischoff; to his
