1 WHEREAS, The untimely passing of John William Overbey of
2 Austin on December 24, 2002, at the age of 12, has brought a tragic
3 loss to the family and many friends of this beloved young man, and
4 it is most appropriate that we honor his memory at this time; and

5 WHEREAS, An Austin native who was named in honor of both his
6 grandfathers, he was born on March 27, 1990, to Kirk and Lisa
7 Overbey, and his close-knit family includes his older sister,
8 Emily; and

9 WHEREAS, John attended St. Theresa's Catholic School through
10 third grade, was a student at St. Louis Catholic School, where he
11 was a favorite among his seventh-grade classmates, and served his
12 fellow congregants of St. Louis Catholic Church as an altar server;

14 WHEREAS, A former Cub Scout, this outstanding young Texan had
15 just earned his Star Rank as a member of Boy Scouts; John especially
16 enjoyed hiking, camping, and fishing with his father and was
17 happily anticipating a winter scouting campout as well as a summer
18 camping trip; while vacationing with his family recently, he had
19 fulfilled a longtime dream by experiencing the sport of
20 snowboarding; and

21 WHEREAS, This sensitive young man delighted his family and
22 friends with his kind heart, sweet spirit, and a joyful sense of
23 humor that kept everyone around him laughing; and

24 WHEREAS, John maintained a creative writing journal, an idea

1 that drew inspiration from J. R. R. Tolkien's *The Lord of the Rings*,
2 and his plans for the future included a desire to become a writer;
3 and

4 WHEREAS, Although it is immeasurably painful to say good-bye
5 to one so young and full of promise, it is fitting to remember that
6 while John's time here was all too brief, his presence profoundly
7 affected all those whose lives he touched; now, therefore, be it

8 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 78th Texas
9 Legislature hereby honor the memory of John William Overbey and
10 extend deepest sympathy to the members of his family: to his
11 parents, Kirk and Lisa Overbey; to his sister, Emily Overbey; to his
12 grandparents, John and Susan Overbey, Lorna Overbey, and William
13 and Darrylin Hudson; to his uncles, Ronald and Darryl Hudson; to his
14 aunts, Kathy and Dorothy Overbey; to his cousin, William Hudson;
15 and to the other relatives and many friends of this cherished young
