R E S O L U T I O N

2 women in the law enforcement profession who, by their selfless  
3 dedication to the public welfare, have enabled us to enjoy the

5           WHEREAS, These gallant individuals daily risk their lives in  
6 order to ensure domestic tranquility and to protect the lives and  
7 property of others; and

8           WHEREAS, Lieutenant Claton "Clay" Morris Medrano of the  
9 Harrison County Sheriff's Department exemplified, in his personal  
10 and professional conduct, the singular virtues of courage,  
11 integrity, and unwavering dedication; and

12           WHEREAS, Throughout his 25 years on the force, his record was  
13 one of meritorious service, loyalty, personal bravery, and  
14 self-sacrifice consistent with the high ideals of the law  
15 enforcement profession; and

16           WHEREAS, This dedicated public servant was killed in the line  
17 of duty on April 27, 2001, and his untimely death was a tragic loss  
18 to his family, to his fellow peace officers, and to the entire  
19 community; and

20           WHEREAS, His legacy of heroic dedication and self-sacrifice  
21 will endure and continue to be a source of inspiration to those who  
22 follow in this difficult but essential profession; now, therefore,

1 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the life of Lieutenant Claton  
2 "Clay" Morris Medrano of the Harrison County Sheriff's Department  
3 and extend deepest sympathy to his family, to his friends, and to
