R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, The Honorable Tony Garza, the United States  
2 Ambassador to Mexico, has been selected as the 2003 Border Texan of  
3 the Year by Hidalgo's Borderfest Association, and this prestigious  
4 designation is indeed well deserved; and

5           WHEREAS, A Brownsville native, Ambassador Garza earned a  
6 bachelor's degree in business administration from The University of  
7 Texas and went on to attain a doctor of jurisprudence degree from  
8 Southern Methodist University (SMU) School of Law; and

9           WHEREAS, This exemplary Texan was drawn to public service and  
10 in 1988 was the first Republican elected to countywide office in  
11 Cameron County; six years later he was appointed Texas Secretary of  
12 State by Governor George Bush, whom he also served as a senior  
13 advisor and as the governor's lead liaison on border and Mexico  
14 affairs; and

15           WHEREAS, Ambassador Garza made another historic mark on the  
16 Texas political landscape in 1998 when he became the first Hispanic  
17 Republican elected to statewide office; as the state's 41st  
18 railroad commissioner, he worked to maintain the strength of our  
19 state's energy sector, while promoting safety and a balanced  
20 approach to the preservation of the state's natural resources; in  
21 addition, he also lent his expertise and commitment to Governor  
22 Rick Perry's Special Commission on 21st Century Colleges and  
23 Universities; and

24           WHEREAS, Ambassador Garza's many accolades include a

1 Distinguished Alumnus Award from SMU School of Law and recognition  
2 as one of five Outstanding Young Texas Exes in 1989, and he has  
3 twice been tabbed by *Hispanic Business Magazine* as one of its "Top  
4 100 Most Influential Hispanics"; and

5 WHEREAS, A distinguished and dedicated public servant,  
6 Ambassador Garza is a credit to this country and to this state, and  
7 it is most appropriate that his significant achievements be  
8 celebrated at this time; now, therefore, be it

9 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 78th Texas  
10 Legislature hereby congratulate Ambassador Tony Garza on being  
11 named 2003 Border Texan of the Year and extend to him sincere best  
12 wishes for continued success in all his endeavors; and, be it
