1           WHEREAS, On March 3, 2003, Dr. Ted Kitchens of Aledo is  
2 serving as Pastor of the Day for the Texas House of Representatives;  
3 and

4           WHEREAS, A graduate of The University of Texas at Arlington,  
5 Southwestern Theological Seminary, and Dallas Theological  
6 Seminary, where he obtained both master's and doctorate degrees,  
7 Dr. Kitchens joined the newly formed Christ Chapel Bible Church in  
8 1981; during his wise and able stewardship, the church has grown  
9 from serving approximately 60 members to ministering to more than  
10 2,000 worshipers on a typical Sunday; over the last two decades, the  
11 number of weekly services has tripled, and the church staff has  
12 increased tenfold; and

13           WHEREAS, Dr. Kitchens has established highly successful  
14 youth ministries, which instruct more than 300 children, 200 teens,  
15 and 250 college students; in addition, he has given generously of  
16 his time and talents to the Aledo Young Life Committee and the  
17 Dallas Theological Advisory Council; and

18           WHEREAS, He continues to minister beyond the walls of his  
19 church as he guides us with a spiritual message on this day, and it  
20 is most fitting that the members of this chamber express  
21 appreciation to him for the sharing of his time and energy in behalf  
22 of this body; now, therefore, be it

23           RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 78th Texas  
24 Legislature hereby commend Dr. Ted Kitchens for his inspiring
