R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Since opening its doors on April 24, 1977, Veterans
2 of Foreign Wars Post No. 7768 has provided Zapata County veterans
3 and their families with vital services, while its members have
4 given generously of their time and resources to benefit the local
5 community; and

7 these dedicated citizens who have already made great sacrifices in
8 behalf of their fellow Americans; the men and women of Post No. 7768
9 have banded together in the years following their military service
