12 1974, he continued to work as a geophysical consultant until 1986;

15 Church and a member of the Society of Petroleum Geophysicists, the  
16 American Association of Petroleum Geologists, the Permian Chapter  
17 of the Sons of the American Revolution, and Alpha Tau Omega
