

R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, On March 13, 2003, the El Paso Commission for Women  
2 is inducting Len Golden Price into its Hall of Fame; and

3           WHEREAS, Established in 1985, the commission is composed of  
4 El Paso citizens who are committed to the pursuit of equal rights  
5 and responsibilities for all women; inductees to the organization's  
6 Hall of Fame are recognized in one of five categories, including  
7 arts, civic leadership, education, professional, and public  
8 service; and

9           WHEREAS, Selected for the professional category, Ms. Price  
10 has worked for the City of El Paso since 1988, beginning as an  
11 administrative assistant in the sanitation department,  
12 transferring to the police department nine years ago, and now  
13 holding the highest rank a civilian can hold within the department,  
14 administrative director; and

15           WHEREAS, Overseeing some 200 employees, this esteemed woman  
16 has excelled as a natural leader; in addition to helping to bring  
17 more than \$40 million in grants to the department, she has been  
18 instrumental in opening five new regional command centers and  
19 helped improve the department's automation capabilities, winning  
20 the respect and admiration of both her colleagues and the community  
21 at large; and

22           WHEREAS, The success of the State of Texas, the strength of  
23 our communities, and the overall vitality of American society  
24 depend on the dedication of people like Len Price, who use their

1 considerable talents and resources to serve others, and it is a  
2 privilege to join in honoring her at this time; now, therefore, be  
3 it

4         RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 78th Texas  
5 Legislature hereby congratulate Len G. Price on her induction into  
6 the El Paso Commission for Women's Hall of Fame and extend to her  
7 sincere best wishes for continued success and happiness; and, be it  
8 further

9         RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be  
10 prepared for Ms. Price as an expression of high regard by the Texas  
11 House of Representatives.
