R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, On March 13, 2003, the El Paso Commission for Women
2 is inducting Dr. Sue Shook into its Hall of Fame; and

3 WHEREAS, Established in 1985, the commission is composed of
4 El Paso citizens who are committed to the pursuit of equal rights
5 and responsibilities for all women; inductees to the organization's
6 Hall of Fame are recognized in one of five categories, including
7 arts, civic leadership, education, professional, and public
8 service; and

9 WHEREAS, Selected for the education category, Dr. Shook is
10 the assistant superintendent for instruction in the Socorro
11 Independent School District (SISD), a position from which she has
12 helped the district build an exceptional staff, a first-rate
13 curriculum, and some of the finest educational facilities in the
14 state; and

15 WHEREAS, In addition to her work with SISD, she has taught
16 master's level research and classroom management classes at The
17 University of Texas at El Paso; she was also an invited lecturer at
18 the International Institute for Education Leadership and has held
19 leadership positions in numerous education-related organizations;

21 WHEREAS, The success of the State of Texas, the strength of
22 our communities, and the overall vitality of American society
23 depend on the dedication of people like Sue Shook, who use their
24 considerable talents and resources to serve others, and it is a

1 privilege to join in honoring her at this time; now, therefore, be

3 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 78th Texas
4 Legislature hereby congratulate Dr. Sue Shook on her induction into
5 the El Paso Commission for Women's Hall of Fame and extend to her
