2 community as a firefighter, and for his dedication to the Hewitt
3 community he has been named the 2003 Hewitt Hero; and

5 Volunteer Fire Department shortly after moving to Hewitt in 1975
6 and went on to attain an enviable record of achievement, becoming
7 fire chief after 10 years of service; he brought to that demanding

9 making significant improvements to the department; and

10 WHEREAS, A highly respected public servant, Mr. Lucenay was
11 nominated by no fewer than three people for this notable award, and

15 Fire Protection W. A. Neel Memorial Firefighter of the Year award in
