R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Robert Harold "Tim" Phillips retired as the Missouri
2 City Police Department community liaison officer on July 16, 1999,
3 and brought to a close a remarkable record of public service in
4 behalf of his fellow citizens; and

5 WHEREAS, From his initial assignment with the department as a
6 reserve police officer in 1977 until his retirement 22 years later,
7 this accomplished Texan held many positions of responsibility,
8 including those of patrol officer, sergeant, detective, criminal
9 analyst, firearms instructor, public safety officer, and,
10 ultimately, community liaison officer; and

11 WHEREAS, Greatly admired by his colleagues as well as by the
12 residents of Missouri City, Officer Phillips earned his master
13 peace officer proficiency certification and was a founding member
14 and longtime commander of the department's SWAT team; he was twice
15 selected as Officer of the Year by the 100 Club and received
16 numerous letters of commendation for his achievements; and

17 WHEREAS, For more than two decades, Officer Phillips
18 established a record of meritorious service, loyalty, bravery, and
19 self-sacrifice consistent with the highest ideals of the law
20 enforcement profession, and his myriad contributions will not soon
21 be forgotten; now, therefore, be it

22 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 78th Texas
23 Legislature hereby commend Robert Harold "Tim" Phillips for his
24 distinguished career with the Missouri City Police Department and

1 extend to him sincere best wishes for a happy and rewarding
2 retirement; and, be it further
