1 WHEREAS, Richard A. Wiley retired from his position as a
2 detective with the Missouri City Police Department on April 30,
3 2002, bringing to a close an exemplary career in law enforcement
4 that spanned more than a quarter-century; and

5 WHEREAS, After serving with the sheriff's office in McLennan
6 and Fort Bend counties, this noteworthy public servant joined the
7 Missouri City Police Department in 1981 as an officer in the patrol
8 division and became a field training officer the following year;

10 WHEREAS, In 1986, he was promoted to the rank of detective,
11 and his work in that capacity included serving as the department's
12 gang liaison; Detective Wiley gained further advancement in 2001
13 when he became acting detective sergeant; and

14 WHEREAS, In recognition of his significant contributions to
15 public safety, he received numerous letters of commendation over
16 the course of his career, and he was named 100 Club Officer of the
17 Year in 1990; and

18 WHEREAS, For 27 years Richard Wiley fulfilled the duties of
19 his office in a manner consistent with the highest ideals of the law
20 enforcement profession, and he may reflect with pride on the
21 significant role he played in protecting the lives and property of
22 his fellow citizens; now, therefore, be it

23 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 78th Texas
24 Legislature hereby commend Richard A. Wiley on his outstanding
