R E S O L U T I O N

2 at Houston Heights Tower, as she is the only original resident who
3 still resides in the facility; and

5 Mrs. Hulme graduated from Louisiana State University and became a
6 first-grade teacher; this extraordinary woman has traveled
7 extensively throughout the United States, Europe, and Mexico; and

9 children, Ann Sloan, Patricia Brison, and Jimmy Hulme, and a
10 devoted grandmother of five and great-grandmother of three; and

12 charter member of the Republican Club and was invited to the
13 inauguration of former President George Bush; Mrs. Hulme is a
14 50-year member of Saint Andrews Episcopal Church and taught Sunday
15 school and Bible school for 20 years; and

16 WHEREAS, When Houston Heights Tower opened its doors in 1975,
17 Mrs. Hulme was one of its first residents, and though the facility
18 has grown and changed over the years, this lovely woman remains a
19 symbol of constancy and a living reminder of the history of this
