1 WHEREAS, Thousands of U.S. troops have been mobilized for
2 action against the current Iraqi regime; and

3 WHEREAS, This country is united in praying for the safety of
4 these brave men and women and for a swift end to the conflict at
5 hand; the nation prays, too, that the sacrifice and heroism of these
6 troops will make possible the emergence of a new democratic society
7 in Iraq, one that recognizes and protects the dignity of all its
8 people and that draws its strength from their untrammelled talents;

10 WHEREAS, Americans owe an immeasurable debt to the members of
11 our armed forces, whose efforts have secured this country's own
12 treasured liberties for more than 200 years, and whose devotion to
13 duty, honor, and the cause of freedom is deserving of their fellow
14 citizens' deepest pride and gratitude; and

15 WHEREAS, At this time of grave crisis, we recognize the
16 American troops deployed to Iraq and the Persian Gulf for the
17 tremendous burdens they have assumed in behalf of their country,
18 and we keep them in our thoughts and hearts as they face the arduous
19 days ahead; now, therefore, be it

20 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 78th Texas
21 Legislature hereby express its support for the American troops now
22 engaged in the Iraqi campaign and extend to them its profound hopes
23 for a successful conclusion to their mission and their safe return.
