

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, The passing of Joseph (Jose) Lord Tweedy, Jr., on
2 December 22, 2002, at the age of 83, brought a great loss to the
3 family and friends of this esteemed gentleman; and

4 WHEREAS, Born to Jose and Eva Browne Tweedy on March 29, 1919,
5 in Plainfield, New Jersey, Mr. Tweedy spent his formative years on
6 the family farm at Knickerbocker near San Angelo; he attended San
7 Angelo schools before being accepted to Phillips Exeter Academy,
8 and he went on to attend Yale University; and

9 WHEREAS, After his father's death, Mr. Tweedy and his
10 cousins, Andrew M. Tweedy, Jr., and Lawrence L. Tweedy, Jr.,
11 accepted the responsibilities of managing the family farm; in 1942,
12 he again followed in his father's footsteps by joining the U.S.
13 military, and he eventually flew 35 missions over Germany as a B-24
14 pilot; and

15 WHEREAS, At the conclusion of World War II, Mr. Tweedy
16 returned to the Lone Star State and earned a degree in accounting
17 from The University of Texas; he joined the accounting department
18 of Lone Star Steel and put his skills as a certified public
19 accountant to good use for a number of years; and

20 WHEREAS, An active member of his community, Mr. Tweedy was a
21 member and treasurer of the Tom Green County Historical Commission
22 and served on the Knickerbocker Community Center's board of
23 directors; he was recently elected program chairman for the Tom
24 Green Historical Society and was a longtime member of Emmanuel

1 Episcopal Church; and

2 WHEREAS, Although his passing has left a void in the lives of
3 the many people who were privileged to know this remarkable man, his
4 spirit will live on in their hearts and minds, and his legacy of
5 good works will not soon be forgotten; now, therefore, be it

6 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 78th Texas
7 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the life of Joseph (Jose) Lord
8 Tweedy, Jr., and extend heartfelt sympathy to the members of his
9 family: to his wife, Harriett Monroe Tweedy; to his stepchildren,
10 Dr. R. Scott Jones and his wife, Carol; Leslie Wilkinson and her
11 husband, Steve; and Debbie Newlin and her husband, Billy; to his
12 sisters, Katharine Waring and Anne Ardery and her husband, Philip;
13 to his nieces, nephews, and cousins; and to his many other relatives
14 and friends; and, be it further

15 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be
16 prepared for his family and that when the Texas House of
17 Representatives adjourns this day, it do so in memory of Joseph
