2 the line of duty on February 11, 2002, and the tragic passing of
3 this heroic individual has deeply saddened the community he served
4 and all who were privileged to know him; and

5 WHEREAS, Vincent Davis exemplified, in his personal and
6 professional conduct, the singular virtues of courage, integrity,
7 and unwavering dedication; and

8 WHEREAS, A native of East St. Louis, Illinois, he worked as an
9 architectural draftsman for the City of Dallas before becoming a
10 firefighter in 1990; and

11 WHEREAS, Throughout his 10 years with the Dallas Fire
12 Department, this outstanding public servant established a record of
13 meritorious service, loyalty, personal courage, and self-sacrifice
14 consistent with the highest ideals of the fire-fighting profession;

16 WHEREAS, Vincent Davis was a passionate defender of life and
17 property, and while he will be greatly missed, the legacy of
18 integrity and bravery he leaves behind will not soon be forgotten;
19 now, therefore, be it

20 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 78th Texas
21 Legislature hereby honor the life of Vincent Llyonell Davis and
22 extend sincere sympathy to his family: to his wife, Dorothy; to his
23 children, Tiffany, Kiarra, Brittany, Breyana, and Vincent Davis,
