1 WHEREAS, With his passing on January 25, 2002, at the age of
2 80, Heriberto "Beto" San Miguel of Del Rio left behind a family whom
3 he treasured and a legacy of love; and

4 WHEREAS, Born on May 21, 1921, in Zaragoza, Coahuila, Mexico,
5 Mr. San Miguel moved his young family to Del Rio in 1954 so that they
6 might find greater opportunity and a brighter future in their new
7 home; he counted among his proudest times the day he and his family
8 became American citizens, and he was deeply touched by his sons'
9 patriotic service in behalf of this nation as members of the armed
10 forces; and

11 WHEREAS, This hardworking Texan was employed as a laborer and
12 migrant worker in the early years of his career, and he went on to
13 gain employment with the San Felipe-Del Rio Consolidated
14 Independent School District as a groundskeeper in the years before
15 his retirement; and

16 WHEREAS, A devoted husband and father, Mr. San Miguel enjoyed
17 a happy and rewarding marriage with his wife, Maria De Jesus
18 Richarte San Miguel, until her death, and he took great pride in the
19 accomplishments of his cherished children, grandchildren, and
20 great-grandchildren; and

21 WHEREAS, Mr. San Miguel gladly gave back to his community,
22 volunteering alongside his children at activities throughout Del
23 Rio, including the annual Feast of Sharing; and

24 WHEREAS, Though Mr. San Miguel has been deeply missed, the

1 memory of his devotion to his family and community will forever
2 endure in the hearts of all those who were privileged to know him;
3 now, therefore, be it

4 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 78th Texas
5 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the life of Heriberto "Beto" San
6 Miguel and extend sincere sympathy to the members of his family: to
7 his daughter, Argentina San Miguel; to his sons and
8 daughters-in-law, Oscar and Delores San Miguel and Joe and Conchita
9 San Miguel; to his grandchildren, Sandra San Miguel, Oscar San
10 Miguel, Jr., and his wife, Sandra, and Lisa Rodriguez and her
11 husband, Arturo; to his great-grandchildren, Alanis Monet San
12 Miguel, Cisco Sebastian San Miguel, Jacqueline Victoria Rodriguez,
