R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Chas Skelly of Azle High School has achieved a
2 pinnacle of success by winning the 2003 UIL state wrestling
3 championship in the 140-pound weight class; and

4 WHEREAS, Having earned two silver medals in three previous
5 trips to the state tournament, he entered the 2003 meet determined
6 to take home the coveted state title; Mr. Skelly faced defending
7 state champion Keegan Mueller of Highland Park High School in the
8 final match, and although hampered by a cut, he refused to be
9 denied, winning 6-0 to claim the gold medal; and

10 WHEREAS, For his remarkable efforts, Mr. Skelly was selected
11 outstanding wrestler at the 2003 meet, and he also led Azle to a
12 fifth-place finish in the overall team standings; and

15 and it is indeed appropriate that he receive special legislative
16 recognition at this time; now, therefore, be it
