1 WHEREAS, Residents of Mission lost a beloved friend,
2 neighbor, and educator, with the passing of Maria Elena "Mary"
3 Gonzalez on April 5, 2002, and it is most fitting to remember this
4 beloved woman on the anniversary of her passing; and

5 WHEREAS, Mrs. Gonzalez graduated from Our Lady of Guadalupe
6 Catholic School and Mission High School before earning a bachelor's
7 degree in elementary education from The University of Texas--Pan
8 American in 1968; she went on to attain a master's degree in
9 educational diagnostics in 1975; and

10 WHEREAS, She returned to the Mission schools and embarked on
11 an impressive career with the school district that spanned three
12 decades, including eight years teaching in the special education
13 department and 16 more working with students in the Pearson
14 Elementary School gifted and talented program; she spent the last
15 six years of her career serving as an educational diagnostician
16 with the special education department, retiring on May 31, 2000;

18 WHEREAS, An active member of St. Paul's Catholic Church, Mrs.
19 Gonzalez taught Catechism of Christian Doctrine, as well as
20 baptism, confirmation, holy communion, and marriage preparation

23 Gonzalez dedicated her life to serving others, and while she is
24 greatly missed, her memory lives on in the hearts and minds of the
