1           WHEREAS, Teresa Rutherford of Colleyville has been selected  
2 as 2002 Realtor of the Year by the Northeast Tarrant County  
3 Association of Realtors; and

4           WHEREAS, A graduate of San Angelo Central High School and the  
5 University of Wisconsin, Ms. Rutherford began her career as a  
6 realtor in 1978 and has worked in the Dallas/Fort Worth mid-cities  
7 area since 1989; she has attained three designations in her chosen  
8 field: ABR--accredited buyer's representative, CRP--certified  
9 relocation professional, and LTG--leadership training graduate,  
10 the latter accorded by the Women's Council of Realtors; and

11           WHEREAS, Ms. Rutherford and her real estate partner, Brenda  
12 Cole, form one of the top multimillion-dollar producing teams  
13 affiliated with the Coldwell Banker Residential Brokerage office in  
14 Southlake; while rendering exceptional service to her clients, Ms.  
15 Rutherford has also devoted many hours to such professional  
16 organizations as the Northeast Tarrant County Association of  
17 Realtors, Texas Association of Realtors, and Builders Association
