1 WHEREAS, Ten students at The University of Texas School of
2 Law were selected to receive this year's UT Co-Op Public Interest
3 Awards totaling \$50,000 for their exceptional work in providing
4 legal assistance and representation to Texans of all ages and
5 backgrounds; these students, who will graduate on May 17, 2003,
6 include Layla Aflatooni, Andrea Beleno, Luis Figueroa, Shavondalyn
7 Givens, Eliza Hirst, Christina Mann, Marilee Manning, Katherine
8 Saunders, Erica Schommer, and Shannon Lee Snead; and

9 WHEREAS, Chosen by William Powers, dean of The University of
10 Texas School of Law, with the assistance of Eden Harrington, the
11 director of the Center for Public Interest Law, the students have
12 provided legal aid to victims of domestic violence, to indigent and
13 low-income Texans, to death row inmates, and to abused and
14 neglected children; they have also helped combat employment
15 discrimination and promoted international human rights and have
16 worked with the Texas Legislature, state agencies, communities, and
17 nonprofit groups on a wide variety of issues; and

19 have demonstrated great compassion and an unwavering dedication to
20 creating a stronger and more just society, and their selfless
21 actions are a source of inspiration to all who know them; now,
