RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, The Texas Council of Child Welfare Boards (TCCWB) provides support to a statewide network of concerned citizens who 2 3 are endeavoring to address the needs of children in their communities, especially those who are abused and neglected; and 4 5 WHEREAS, Child welfare boards originated in 1931, when the 6 Texas Legislature authorized county commissioners courts to appoint boards that would coordinate local protective services for 7 children; at the same time, the legislature created the Division of 8 Child Welfare Services (DCWS), originally part of the State Board 9 of Control; DCWS has become Child Protective Services, one of four 10 11 major programs within the Department of Protective and Regulatory 12 Services; and 13 WHEREAS, Before 1939, when the state assumed responsibility 14 for the protection of children with the establishment of the State Department of Public Welfare, the county child welfare boards often 15 furnished services to families and children themselves, with 16 guidance from the DCWS staff; today one of the responsibilities of 17 18 these boards is to oversee county expenditures for child welfare services; and 19 WHEREAS, In 1976, regional child welfare advisory councils 20 21 began to be established, bringing together representatives of 22 county boards, and in 1978 the TCCWB was created; today the state council is composed of members representing 11 regional councils, 23 which in turn represent 212 county child welfare boards; and 24

WHEREAS, Members of the TCCWB collaborate with the staffs of Child Protective Services and other agencies and organizations to promote services to abused and neglected children and to prevent the occurrence of abusive treatment; the scale of the challenge facing the TCCWB and allied groups is suggested by the estimate that 8.5 percent of Texas children are at risk for some sort of abuse or neglect; and

WHEREAS, The TCCWB is committed to creating a society in which all children know the security of a loving, nurturing, and safe environment, and its work has ramifications that touch all Texans; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 78th Texas Legislature hereby honor the Texas Council of Child Welfare Boards on the occasion of its 25th anniversary and extend to all its members sincere appreciation for their outstanding efforts in a crucial cause.
