

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Wichita Falls community leaders have formed the
2 Zavala Hispanic Cultural Initiative and are working to establish
3 the Zavala Hispanic Cultural Center to address leadership and
4 involvement issues affecting the area's Hispanic population; and

5 WHEREAS, In May 2002, approximately 70 individuals met to
6 discuss how to best encourage Hispanic leadership in the Wichita
7 Falls community; to accomplish goals laid out for the group,
8 participants formed the initiative and its steering committee and
9 are now investigating prospective locations for a center that will
10 provide quality child care, English and Spanish classes, social and
11 health care agency services, and a place for fellowship; and

12 WHEREAS, Members of the Zavala Hispanic Cultural Initiative
13 are also taking advantage of various training and educational
14 opportunities; some will participate in Leadership Wichita Falls, a
15 program designed to familiarize individuals with the city and build
16 leadership skills, and others will attend Leadership 2003, which is
17 sponsored by the Center for Nonprofit Management; and

18 WHEREAS, Wichita County's Hispanic population, which is
19 predicted to triple by 2040, is making lasting, positive
20 contributions to the Wichita Falls community and surrounding areas,
21 and the Zavala Hispanic Cultural Initiative and Cultural Center are
22 notable endeavors worthy of special recognition; now, therefore, be
23 it
