15 the assistant deputy commissioner for mental retardation services;  
16 she ascended the ranks of the organization, serving as an  
17 administrator of consumer and employee safety and health-related  
18 programs, before assuming her current post in 1982; and

19           WHEREAS, Ms. Carley is also a longstanding leader on the  
20 Employees Retirement System Board of Trustees; she has been a  
21 member of the board since 1984, and over the course of her  
22 three-term tenure, she has ably served as both its chair and vice  
23 chair; and

24           WHEREAS, Ms. Carley has won widespread respect and admiration
