7 Paso businessman and politician who played a key role in the growth
8 of health care and health education in El Paso; and

9 WHEREAS, A three-term El Paso mayor, Dr. Williams served on
10 the Board of Regents of Texas Tech University and the Texas Tech
11 University School of Medicine from 1969 to 1979, chairing the board
12 from 1976 to 1979; his visionary leadership and sage guidance were
13 truly beneficial to the successful growth and development of the
14 center; and

15 WHEREAS, Through his exemplary contributions to the Texas
16 Tech University Health Sciences Center, Judson F. Williams helped
17 to establish Texas Tech El Paso as a valuable resource for health
18 care education and delivery for the citizens of West Texas, and his
19 unwavering devotion to the well-being of his fellow Texans will not
20 soon be forgotten; now, therefore, be it
