1           WHEREAS, Kathleen Rodriguez has been hired by The University  
2 of Texas at El Paso (UTEP) to develop and coach the school's new  
3 softball team; and

4           WHEREAS, The first female minority head coach in UTEP's  
5 history, Coach Rodriguez compiled a 168-158-1 record as the head  
6 softball coach at Eastern New Mexico University and Schreiner  
7 University, where she was charged with establishing the school's  
8 softball program; in 2001 she was named Lone Star Conference Coach  
9 of the Year after leading Eastern New Mexico to the conference and  
10 regional championships and a fifth-place national ranking; and

11           WHEREAS, Coach Rodriguez's record of success as an athlete,  
12 student, and teacher is truly remarkable; an all-state high school  
13 player and a four-year starter at St. Mary's University, she earned  
14 a degree in exercise and sports science in 1994; she has coached  
15 three All-Americans, one conference player of the year, 29  
16 All-Conference players, 24 Academic All-Conference honorees, 10  
17 Academic All-District selections, and 22 Academic All-Americans;

21 of her husband, James, and her two sons, Ryan and Aryn, she will
