1 WHEREAS, Architecture, Planning, and Historic Preservation,
2 Inc., more commonly known as ARCHITEXAS, marks the silver
3 anniversary of its founding in 2003, and this memorable occasion
4 indeed merits our special recognition; and

5 WHEREAS, Since 1978, the company established by Dallas
6 natives Craig Melde and Gary Skotnicki has specialized in historic
7 preservation, planning, and compatible new design in historical
8 context; today, ARCHITEXAS is the state's largest historic
9 preservation architecture firm; and

10 WHEREAS, The company was founded in part to counteract the
11 razing of historic Dallas buildings, a trend highly unsettling to
12 individuals who support historic preservation and who witness the
13 destruction of architectural landmarks; and

14 WHEREAS, By the 1990s, ARCHITEXAS was making strides in
15 historic preservation throughout the city--in the West End, Swiss
16 Avenue, and the development of the Sammons Center for the Arts in
17 the Turtle Creek Pump Station--as well as statewide, and today its
18 work can be seen in counties throughout Texas; and

19 WHEREAS, ARCHITEXAS has greatly enhanced the quality of life
20 of Texas residents by working in behalf of the preservation of the
21 state's historic buildings and landmarks, and it is a pleasure to
22 salute this outstanding Texas company; now, therefore, be it

24 Legislature hereby commemorate the 25th anniversary of the founding
