WHEREAS, An avid duck and goose hunter, Mr. Di Iorio gave generously of his time and talents in behalf of the Boy and Girl Scouts and Katy Christian Ministries food pantry; he was a founding member of St. Bartholomew Catholic Church in Katy and the first post commander for the Floyd E. Breedlove VFW Post No. 9182; and

WHEREAS, Jim Di Iorio was a man of integrity, dedication, and strong faith, and while he will be greatly missed, his memory will
