1 WHEREAS, The death of Euless physician Don Roger Warren on
2 April 6, 2003, at the age of 74, has brought a great loss to the many
3 friends, relatives, patients, and colleagues of this truly beloved
4 Texan; and

5 WHEREAS, Born on January 20, 1929, in Marshall, Dr. Warren
6 was educated at The University of Texas Medical Branch at Galveston
7 and set up his family medicine practice in Euless in 1960; a
8 cherished friend and physician to many generations of
9 area families, he was for a time one of only two doctors in Euless,
10 and he will be long remembered for his three decades of service as
11 team doctor for the Trinity High School football program; and

12 WHEREAS, Dr. Warren, a licensed pilot who loved taking his
13 friends and neighbors on flights, proved himself to be a public
14 servant and medical professional of the highest caliber; in
15 addition to being the on-call emergency physician for the City of
16 Euless, this caring North Texan was an outstanding member of the
17 Euless City Council from 1964 to 1972; and

18 WHEREAS, Those who were privileged to know Dr. Warren will
19 not soon forget the kindness, compassion, and integrity he brought
20 to every facet of his life, and although his presence is gone from
21 us now, his memory will continue to live on in the hearts of all
22 those whose lives he touched during his years on this earth; now,
