- 1 WHEREAS, Words cannot adequately express the sorrow felt at
- 2 the loss of First Sergeant Robert J. Dowdy of DeRidder, Louisiana,
- 3 who died in the Iraqi campaign at the age of 38; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Sergeant Dowdy, a mechanical maintenance
- 5 supervisor, was one of nine soldiers from the army's 507th
- 6 Maintenance Company who lost their lives following an ambush in
- 7 southern Iraq on March 23, 2003; he had volunteered for deployment
- 8 to the Persian Gulf in the place of a fellow soldier and had shipped
- 9 out from Fort Bliss the previous month; for his valiant service in
- 10 Operation Iraqi Freedom, Sergeant Dowdy was posthumously awarded a
- 11 Bronze Star and a Purple Heart; and
- 12 WHEREAS, This courageous soldier graduated in 1982 from South
- 13 High School in Cleveland, Ohio; an 18-year army veteran, he was an
- 14 able leader, one whose integrity and sound judgment naturally
- 15 commanded the respect of others; he received promotion to first
- 16 sergeant in Kuwait, shortly before moving into Iraq; and
- 17 WHEREAS, In his leisure time, Sergeant Dowdy was an
- 18 accomplished runner who participated in numerous races in the El
- 19 Paso area; and
- 20 WHEREAS, Though his work necessitated spending many hours
- 21 away from his family, his profound care and support for his wife and
- 22 daughter knew no limit; and
- 23 WHEREAS, Americans owe an immeasurable debt to their military
- 24 personnel, whose brave and steadfast efforts have long secured this

- 1 nation's freedom; through his unwavering devotion to duty, honor,
- 2 and his country, Sergeant Dowdy embodied the highest ideals of the
- 3 United States armed forces, and the State of Texas and the nation
- 4 now mourn the loss of a hero who made the ultimate sacrifice in
- 5 behalf of his country, and whose life was a treasured blessing to
- 6 all who were privileged to share his love and friendship; now,
