R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, In July 2002, Robert Aguilar of El Paso was named  
2 assistant principal of Glen Cove Elementary School, a significant  
3 step in this remarkable gentleman's decade-long quest to become  
4 principal of Glen Cove; and

5           WHEREAS, Mr. Aguilar was hired as a school janitor in 1992 and  
6 he set a goal of becoming principal of the school; after sharing his  
7 dream with his colleagues, he received a great deal of  
8 encouragement and, in 1993, at the age of 27, he enrolled in his  
9 first class at El Paso Community College; and

13 Elementary School and Parkview Alternative Middle School and as a

15           WHEREAS, A role model for students and teachers alike, he  
16 continued his pursuit of higher education and earned a master's  
17 degree in administration from Sul Ross State University in 2002 and  
18 accepted the position of assistant principal at Glen Cove shortly  
19 thereafter; and

20           WHEREAS, Mr. Aguilar's success story is indeed an inspiration  
21 and it is a pleasure to pay tribute to him and recognize his faith  
22 and commitment in the pursuit of excellence; now, therefore, be it

23           RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 78th Texas  
24 Legislature hereby congratulate Mr. Aguilar on being named

1 assistant principal of Glen Cove Elementary School and commend him  
2 for his dedication to achieving his goals and for his continued
