RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, During the month of May 2003, the American Stroke 2 Association, a division of the American Heart Association, is 3 promoting an educational campaign designed to inform the public 4 about the risk factors, warning signs, and symptoms of stroke; and

5 WHEREAS, Every 45 seconds, someone in America has a stroke, 6 and every 3 minutes, someone dies of one; approximately 700,000 7 Americans experience strokes each year, and some 4.7 million 8 Americans are presently stroke survivors; the chance of having a 9 stroke before the age of 70 is 1 in 20 for both men and women; and

10 WHEREAS, A leading cause of long-term disability and the 11 third leading cause of death in the United States, strokes annually 12 result in the death or disability of more than 9,800 Texans; and

13 WHEREAS, The majority of Americans are not aware of their 14 risk factors for a stroke, nor are they aware of the signs and symptoms of an impending stroke; warning signs of stroke include: 15 sudden numbness or weakness of the face, arm, or leg, especially on 16 one side of the body; sudden confusion or trouble speaking or 17 understanding; sudden trouble seeing in one or both eyes; sudden 18 dizziness, trouble walking, or loss of balance or coordination; and 19 20 sudden severe headache with no known cause; and

21 WHEREAS, To emphasize the vital importance of stroke victims' 22 receiving prompt medical attention, the theme for this year's 23 stroke awareness campaign is "Time = Brain"; new and effective 24 means have been developed to treat and minimize the severity and

1 damaging effects of strokes, among them t-PA, a clot-busting drug 2 that should be administered within three hours of onset of 3 symptoms; and
