22 received the Champion for Children award from the American
23 Association of School Administrators and the Edward A. Smith Award
24 for Excellence for his extraordinary leadership; and

2 is a community challenge; through his endeavors to guarantee that
3 all young Texans receive a sound education, Mr. Milliken helps to
4 ensure that the Lone Star State has a competent workforce and a
5 stable and competitive economy; now, therefore, be it
