7 the county seat of Duval County; the school was known as San Diego
8 Junior High until 1985, when it was renamed in honor of the revered

11 including former state legislators Ignacio Salinas and Orlando
12 Garcia; and

16 the students of Benita Trejo's seventh-grade Texas history class to
