4 WHEREAS, Chartered on September 22, 1853, the Bexar County
5 Medical Society is the oldest organization of its kind in Texas and
6 the eighth largest in the nation; and

8 the public health by being a leader in the fight to eradicate such
9 serious health threats as typhoid, smallpox, tuberculosis, and
10 polio; and

11 WHEREAS, It has also been involved in a host of worthwhile
12 health initiatives, including the first community blood bank in
13 Bexar County, the emergency medical response and transport system,
14 fluoridation of public drinking water, and a ban on smoking in
15 public places; and

17 County Medical Society has demonstrated a deeply rooted commitment
18 to addressing the health concerns of South Texas, and it is a
19 pleasure to honor this organization for its myriad contributions to
