R E S O L U T I O N

20 is an active member of St. Rose of Lima Catholic Church, and he has
21 given generously of his time and talents in behalf of this fine
22 organization; the American Cancer Society and Little Thicket Park
23 have also benefited from his volunteer services; and

1 pursuit of his goals have proven Eagle Scout Kapalski worthy to
2 stand among scouting's elite, and it is most appropriate that he be
3 honored at this time; now, therefore, be it
