5 December 19, 1934, to Albert Enno Kaepfel and Mildred Sheffield
6 Kaepfel; after graduating from Rice University and The University
7 of Texas Medical Branch at Galveston, he completed his internship
8 and residency at Hermann Hospital and served two years in the United
9 States Navy Medical Corps in Guam; and

11 successful private medical practice from 1966 to 1999, and he later
12 served as director of obstetrics and gynecology at Memorial Family
13 Practice; beloved by colleagues and patients alike, he was an
14 active member of many professional societies, including the Harris
15 County Medical Society, the Texas Medical Association, and the
16 Houston Gynecological and Obstetrical Society; and

17 WHEREAS, In his free time, Dr. Kaepfel enjoyed such diverse
18 interests as woodcarving, camping, fly-fishing, astronomy,
19 attending the opera and symphony, reading, tracing his family's
20 genealogy, and watching college basketball; and

21 WHEREAS, Christopher Kaepfel was a man of wisdom, compassion,
22 and great humor, and while he will be deeply missed, his memory will
23 live on in the hearts and minds of the many people whose lives he
24 touched; now, therefore, be it
