13 carrying the thought of his worried bride deep in his heart
14 throughout the perilous journey; and

15 WHEREAS, After the war, Mr. Casey enjoyed a successful career
16 with Mobil Oil Company, where he was employed until his retirement
17 in 1976, while Mrs. Casey was employed with San Jacinto Junior High
18 School and Lee High School for many years; and

19 WHEREAS, Mr. and Mrs. Casey are valued members of their
20 community and have been devoted congregants of the First Christian
21 Church since 1956; he also belongs to the Air Force Escape and
22 Evasion Society and the Confederate Air Force; and

23 WHEREAS, For 60 years, this loving couple have enjoyed an
24 enduring union filled with many happy times and cherished family

1 memories, and it is a privilege to honor them for all they have
2 accomplished in their life together; now, therefore, be it
