R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, In March 2003, a group of 11 students from The  
2 University of Texas at El Paso (UTEP) traveled to Queretaro,  
3 Mexico, to represent their school at the 22nd Regular Session of the  
4 Model Organization of American States (OAS) General Assembly; and

5           WHEREAS, This Lone Star delegation was one of only three  
6 American teams to be invited by the Government of Mexico and the OAS  
7 General Secretariat to attend this prestigious public policy  
8 competition; composed of students from the UTEP Center for  
9 Inter-American and Border Studies, the team truly rose to the  
10 occasion in its role as the Permanent Mission of Costa Rica and  
11 captured numerous awards and accolades, including the titles of  
12 Best Delegation in the Conference, Best Delegation in the General  
13 Committee, Best Delegation in Economic and Social Affairs, and Best  
14 Delegation in Administrative and Budgetary Matters; and

15           WHEREAS, The entire community of UTEP can be proud of the  
16 exceptional achievements of faculty advisor Tony Payan and the  
17 following students: Julie Flores, General Committee; Carlos  
18 Rodriguez and Gerson Pedrozo, first committee of Juridical and  
19 Political Matters; Christopher Ritchey, second committee A of  
20 Economic and Social Matters; Lucy Zarate, second committee B of  
21 Education, Scientific, and Cultural Matters; Jose Roberto Nakid,  
22 public relations officer; Enrique Flores, who has been named vice  
23 chairman of next year's third committee, Administrative and  
24 Budgetary Matters; Valerie Ann Sanchez, who has been named

1 chairwoman of that same committee; Vince Vita, who has been named  
2 chairman of next year's second committee B of Education,  
3 Scientific, and Cultural Matters; and Eduardo Barbosa, who has been  
4 named president of the 23rd Regular Session of the Model OAS General  
5 Assembly; their accomplishments are all the more impressive  
6 considering that this was the UTEP delegation's first foray into  
7 international competition; now, therefore, be it
