1 WHEREAS, Area residents can take great pride in Blue Ridge
2 High School students' many notable accomplishments during the
3 2002-2003 school year; and

4 WHEREAS, These young scholars and athletes have reached
5 impressive levels of achievement in wide-ranging fields of
6 endeavor, including academics, sports, the arts, science,
7 agriculture, and journalism; and

8 WHEREAS, The science team placed first in problem solving at
9 the Winston Science Fair in Dallas while three students advanced to
10 the Regional UIL Academic Meet in computer applications and
11 newspaper writing; actors and crew involved with the one-act play
12 were rewarded with all-star cast, technical, and best actor prizes,
13 before going on to earn additional all-star cast and technical
14 awards at region; and

15 WHEREAS, Blue Ridge is home to numerous top-ranked athletes,
16 including the District 2A champion boys' basketball team, which
17 advanced to the regional quarterfinals, and the boys' baseball
18 team, winner of the 13AA district and bi-district titles; the
19 football team competed in the Class 2A Division II playoff game, and
20 the cross-country squad earned a berth at region, as did a senior
21 member of the power-lifting team; and

22 WHEREAS, At the district tennis meet, the girls earned a
23 second place in doubles and went to the regional tournament; the
24 girls' golf team won second place in the team division competition

1 at district, thus qualifying for regional, while a member of the
2 boys' golf team advanced as a medalist to regional; and

3 WHEREAS, Today's seniors make up the largest graduating class
4 in the history of the high school, and nearly 40 percent of the
5 Class of 2003 plans to attend college in the fall, with
6 approximately the same percentage currently enrolled in college
7 courses; and

8 WHEREAS, The outstanding young Texans of Blue Ridge High
9 School have set a high standard of achievement for themselves and
10 those who follow in their footsteps, and it is a privilege to honor
11 them at this time; now, therefore, be it

12 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 78th Texas
13 Legislature hereby commend the students, faculty, and staff of Blue
14 Ridge High School for their commitment to excellence and extend to
15 them warmest best wishes for success and happiness in the years to
16 come; and, be it further
