R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, John Dickson is a compassionate and honorable man
2 who is committed to teaching others to care for the less fortunate
3 and to respect the environment; and

4 WHEREAS, He was born in El Paso, grew up in Lavernia, and
5 graduated from Lavernia High School; he continued his education at
6 The University of Texas at San Antonio, eventually transferring to
7 The University of Texas at Arlington, where he is majoring in
8 history; Mr. Dickson is now a resident of Fort Worth; and

9 WHEREAS, Growing up in a large family with grandparents who
10 are veterans of World War II and the Korean War and parents who have
11 more than 60 years of combined experience in the education system,
12 Mr. Dickson developed a deep consciousness of and understanding for

15 its impact on the diversity of the planet, he cofounded Students for
16 Just Peace and traveled to such areas as Washington, D.C., Denver,

20 that one day it will reach its greatest potential through nurturing
21 ideas and diverse values, Mr. Dickson sets an example for others as
22 both a student and a community leader, and it is a pleasure to honor
