1           WHEREAS, African American Leadership Institute Chairman Art  
2 A. Hall of San Antonio is being recognized for his service to the  
3 community on May 31, 2003, with a special certificate of  
4 appreciation; and

5           WHEREAS, Mr. Hall traveled widely for his education,  
6 receiving his bachelor of arts degree from Harvard University and  
7 his J.D. and M.B.A. degrees from Texas Tech University; he also  
8 attended the University of Wales at Aberystwyth in the United  
9 Kingdom and earned his international master of laws degree; and

10           WHEREAS, The work experiences of this attorney and banker are  
11 as distinguished as his education; he has interned for Senator  
12 Edward Kennedy, Governor William Weld, and Texas Supreme Court  
13 Chief Justice Thomas Phillips; Mr. Hall has taught at La  
14 Universidad Espiritu Santo in Ecuador, at St. Mary's Law School in  
15 San Antonio, and at The University of Texas at San Antonio;  
16 furthermore, he has served with distinction as vice president and  
17 general counsel for Southwestern Capital Markets, Inc.; and

24 ability to benefit the YMCA, the Alamo City Chamber of Commerce, and

1 Leadership San Antonio XXVII; named by the *San Antonio Business*  
2 *Journal* as one of San Antonio's 1999 "Rising Stars Top 40 Under 40,"  
3 Mr. Hall is an Eagle Scout who has selflessly volunteered to help  
4 young people to succeed by participating in the Northside  
5 Independent School District's Gifted and Talented Mentorship  
6 Program; and
