1 WHEREAS, Since 1979, the Greater Houston Preservation
2 Alliance has recognized local contributors to the preservation,
3 restoration, and enhancement of Houston's architectural heritage
4 through the presentation of its Good Brick Award, and it is a
5 pleasure to join in honoring one of this year's deserving
6 recipients; and

7 WHEREAS, The residence located at 2337 Blue Bonnet was
8 originally constructed in 1937 by Harold Calhoun using a
9 construction system called Stran-Steel, and its clean lines fit in
10 well with Houston's image as a modern city; when it was completed,
11 the home was featured in numerous national magazines as an
12 excellent example of international style architecture; and

13 WHEREAS, In 2001, Courtney and Fred Steves purchased the
14 home, which had been neglected and was in much need of repair; they
15 hired Glassman Shoemake Maldonado Architects to assist them in
16 restoring it, and with meticulous research and extreme care, they
17 were able to realize this dream, even retaining much of the home's
18 original cabinetry, built-ins, bathroom fixtures, furniture, and
19 exterior facade; and

20 WHEREAS, A true architectural treasure, this structure is yet
21 again a valued part of the Houston landscape, and its beauty and
22 charm is certain to be admired for years to come; now, therefore, be
