2 distinguished tenure for Esther Polland as president of the Jewish
3 Federation of Greater Houston; and

5 esteemed woman has demonstrated tremendous dedication to her

7 exemplary leader, and her efforts have helped to raise in excess of
8 \$20 million for charitable activities in the U.S. and beyond and
9 have won her the lasting respect and admiration of all who have been

12 organization, including terms as its vice president, general
13 campaign chair, and women's division campaign chair; and

18 Hillel in Austin, Ms. Polland has committed herself to preserving
