- WHEREAS, The year 2003 marks the 50th anniversary of the
- 2 founding of KUHT-TV Channel 8 in Houston, and this milestone truly
- 3 merits special legislative recognition; and
- 4 WHEREAS, The first educational television station in the
- 5 nation, KUHT-TV was established by Walter W. Kemmerer, the
- 6 president of the University of Houston (UH); the station's
- 7 inaugural broadcast was on May 25, 1953, from the fifth floor of the
- 8 Ezekiel W. Cullen Building on the UH campus; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Shortly thereafter, KUHT-TV began broadcasting
- 10 college credit courses in psychology, English, sciences, and the
- 11 arts, and by 1964, the station had moved to a more powerful
- 12 transmitter that allowed the signal to reach more than 20
- 13 surrounding counties; and
- 14 WHEREAS, After UH became a state institution in the late
- 15 1960s, the Association for Community Television was created to
- 16 serve as KUHT-TV's support and fund-raising arm; over the ensuing
- decade, the station became part of the nascent Public Broadcasting
- 18 Service, which provided audiences the opportunity to see such
- 19 acclaimed programs as Nova and Masterpiece Theatre; and
- WHEREAS, In 1985, KUHT-TV became the first station in Houston
- 21 to air programming in high-fidelity stereo, and this advancement
- 22 further enhanced the viewing experience for fans of Evening at
- 23 Pops, Austin City Limits, Cosmos, MacNeil/Lehrer Newshour, Sesame
- 24 Street, and many other beloved shows; and
