RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, The Distinguished Flying Cross is awarded by the United States of America to members of the armed forces who have 2 3 demonstrated heroism or extraordinary achievement while participating in an aerial flight, involving an accomplishment so 4 5 exceptional and so outstanding as to clearly set the individual apart from others operating in similar circumstances; this military 6 decoration is reserved for only the most elite men and women in 7 uniform, and the Lone Star State is privileged to be the home state 8 of one such recipient of the medal, Captain Nathan Howard of the 9 United States Air Force; and 10

WHEREAS, Captain Howard, a member of the 1991 class of Round 11 12 Rock High School and a graduate of Texas A&M University, is the son 13 of Lois Howard and retired Air Force pilot Lieutenant Colonel J. 14 Robert Howard; on the night of April 7, 2003, over the skies of northern Iraq, he piloted his KC-135 tanker deep into enemy 15 territory to refuel fighter planes that were conducting, with 16 critically low fuel supplies, a combat search-and-rescue mission 17 (CSAR) for a downed F-15; even when not performed under such dire 18 combat conditions, the act of mid-air refueling is considered 19 exceptionally dangerous, and it was only the skill and bravery of 20 21 Captain Howard and his fellow crew members that enabled the fighter 22 planes to return to base unscathed; and

23 WHEREAS, This remarkable record of military valor has earned 24 Captain Howard the eternal and profound gratitude of his fellow
