R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, The Southwest Texas State University women's
2 basketball team captured the Southland Conference Tournament
3 championship on March 15, 2003, defeating top-seeded UT-San Antonio
4 68-56 in a hotly contested matchup between two top-notch teams; and

5 WHEREAS, In their quest to attain the coveted tournament
6 title, the fourth-seeded Bobcats also defeated second-seeded
7 Stephen F. Austin State University, a victory that marked the first
8 time the Ladyjacks had been defeated on their home court in the
9 history of conference tournament play; and

10 WHEREAS, Schooled in the fundamentals by head coach Suzanne
11 Fox, the Bobcats received outstanding individual performances from
12 tournament MVP Tori Talbert and her fellow All-Tournament honorees
13 Julie Brooks and Heather Burrow; Coach Fox was supported in her
14 efforts by assistant coaches Will Flemons, Noel Johnson, and Megan
15 Kahn and administrative assistant Erin Magee; and

16 WHEREAS, The team also includes Alexis Marshall, Alphalisha
17 Johnson, Aleise Johnson, Sarah Dodds, Ashley McGruder, Christen
18 West, Colter Mize, Erika Pink, Brittany Loney, Ally Kelly, Kristie
19 Hinton, and Mercy Okorie; these dedicated student-athletes
20 demonstrated excellence on and off the court throughout the long
21 season; and

22 WHEREAS, The efforts of the team's coaches and players have
23 helped Southwest Texas State University to gain national exposure
24 that will undoubtedly benefit this venerable institution and all
