2 The Red Poppy Service Unit, has earned the highest award a Cadette
3 Girl Scout can achieve, the Girl Scout Silver Award; and

5 one bestowed on only a fraction of those who enter the scouting
6 movement; in the course of meeting the rank's demanding criteria,
7 Ms. Morris earned a minimum of three interest project patches,

9 activities, and earned the Cadette Girl Scout Leadership Award or
10 Leadership Interest Project patch; and

12 Award project of benefit to members of the community, which
13 involved working at two sessions of Vacation Bible School and, on a
14 mission trip with First United Methodist Church, implementing craft
15 activities for mentally and physically handicapped children; and

17 Christy Lange, this fine young woman has demonstrated outstanding
18 initiative and an unwavering commitment to the ideals of the Girl
19 Scout organization, and her efforts have won her the respect and
20 admiration of her peers; and

21 WHEREAS, Her dedication to excellence and her perseverance in
22 the pursuit of her goals have proven Leeanna Morris worthy to stand
23 among scouting's elite, and it is most appropriate that she be
24 honored at this time; now, therefore, be it
